Information regarding the collection of personal data according to Art. 13 GDPR

2. Purposes and legal basis for processing personal data

EUOPHRAS processes the following personal data:

- For **the purpose of maintaining a membership register**, we process title, first name, surname, date of birth, institution (including address), e-mail address. The legal basis for this is Art. 6 point (b) GDPR.
- For **the purpose of collecting membership fees**, bank details are processed. The legal basis for this is Art. 6 point (b) GDPR.

3. Transfer of personal data

- No data are transferred to third parties
- No data are transferred to third countries.

4. Period of storage

- Personal data necessary for the processing of the membership register (title, first name, surname, date of birth, institution (incl. address), e-mail address) are deleted two years after the respective member's membership has expired.
- Personal data necessary for collecting membership fees (title, first name, surname, date of birth, institution (incl. address), e-mail address, bank details) are deleted after 10 years.
- If consent for data processing is withdrawn, data will be deleted immediately.

5. Rights of the data subject

Each member has a right to access their personal data (Art. 15 GDPR) and a right to request rectification (Art. 16 GDPR) or erasure (Art. 17 GDPR) or restriction of processing of personal data (Art. 18 GDPR) and a right to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR) as well as a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR). Each member has the right to withdraw consent for the processing of his or her personal data. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. Each member has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
